swimming at lakefront is not being conducted as safety plan states; Buddy check are not done during swimming activities CORRECTED: discussed safety plan with Camp Director and Aquatics Director; Aquatics Director and Camp Director both state Buddy checks will be completed as safety plan detailed

ITEM # 7 WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(s). PUBLIC HEALTH HAZARD

no buddy checks at time of inspection; after 20 mins lifeguard was asked by SCDOH if a buddy check was going to be completed; lifeguard stated, "we do not do them at the lake front" a visual assessment is done and checked against buddy board CORRECTED: buddy checks implemented every 15 minutes

camper observed at waterfront skipping stones his buddies were swimming; he was at area of lake where lifeguards backs were to him he stated his troop leader was not with him; there was a troop leader closer to swimming area with other boys scout group was able to see the camper; but he was not responsible for the boy and his buddies when swimming ended two buddies joined him and they headed back towards camp; SCDOH went to camp and asked the 6 troop leaders that were at the camp how they supervise the troop between activities.. they stated attendance is taken at the activity and compared to who signs up in the morning for the activity camper observed wandering by himself upon entering park same camper observed wandering around swimming pool area later in inspection by himself
