Dale Freier, MD made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Lynn Porter seconding it.	Liz gave an updated report on the increase of Pertussis cases that have occurred across the state from January 1, 2024 through December 2, 2024. NYS has seen 1,544 cases (this does not include cases in NYC) compared to 593 cases from all of 2023 (excluding NYC). Over 50% of the cases reported in NYS occurred among individuals between the ages of 10-19, almost all of which were vaccinated.	Scott stated that NYS passed a bill that would allow rural counties some flexibility with populating their BOH members if there is a lack of available physicians to sit on the board. A copy of that legislation was provided to members prior to the meeting.	Scott stated that there are three resolutions for grant renewals going to the Health & Human Services committee for approval on December 23 rd . Scott announced that there are some educational opportunities that will be available for staff members through FLPPS Career Pathways Training Program and the University of Albany SPH Certificate Program. Scott indicated that two current staff members have already applied and been accepted to the UAlbany program. Scott reported that the BOS has adopted the 2025 budget with no cuts to the SCHD budget.
