Liz reported that within the county, there was an increase in COVID cases in March with 57 confirmed cases and one confirmed death of a resident in a nursing home. Influenza cases are starting to decrease across NYS. Currently we have no confirmed cases of measles.	Kim reported that with the start of the 5-year CHIP plan cycle that runs from 2025 through 2030, they have begun to hold focus groups within the community. These focus groups are designed to provide feedback on what health issues the community feels has the biggest impact on them, and what our communities' strengths, weaknesses and assets are.	Scott and Chersti Kuhlmann will be presenting to the Board of Supervisors on April 22 <sup>nd</sup> to discuss the shortage of E.I. Service Providers. They will be discussing some of the options that they think might help alleviate the shortage of providers and will be asking for feedback from the BOS on how to proceed.  Scott stated that one resolution going to the BOS on April 22 <sup>nd</sup> is to request approval to accept the renewal of the Mutual Aid Agreement (FLPHA).  Due to federal budget cuts, Scott reported that he is preparing for the potential loss of the PHEP grant (Public Health Emergency Preparedness).
